Dr. Antigone Samiou teaches European, Comparative and Modern Greek Literature at the Department of Philology of the University of Ioannina, where she serves as a Member of the Laboratory Teaching Staff. She also collaborates with the Hellenic Open University as a supervisor of master theses in the postgraduate programs " Teaching French as a Foreign Language" since 2007 and "Creative Writing" since 2020. In the latter program, she has taught “European Literature” for two years, while she also taught in the undergraduate program "Studies in European Culture" for five years. Her research interests focus on French and comparative literature, with particular emphasis on travel writing. Moreover, they include European drama, as she is academic coordinator and instructor in the annual training program offered by the Centre for Lifelong Learning of the University of Ioannina, entitled "Theatre and Women's Emancipation: From Classical Antiquity to the Modern Era". Finally, she studies the reception of Sophocles’ Antigone in contemporary world drama. She has presented papers at Greek and international conferences, and her studies and articles have been published in Greek and international peer-reviewed journals.
